

CITIZEN'S CHARTER STATE EXCISE DEPARTMENT GOVERNMENT OF UTTRAKHAND

PREAMBLE:-

The objective of this Charter is to provide information regarding the services rendered by the State Excise Department. In order to improve the delivery of the services, the Department has decided to formulate this Citizen's Charter.

Organizational Structure:-

State Excise Department is headed by Excise Commissioner, Uttarakhand. The Commissionerate function under the Excise Department of Government of Uttarakhand.

Office of Excise Commissioner has its headquarter at Tehsil Chock, 15/1, Gandhi Road, Dehradun. Commissioner is the head of Department and if assisted by officials arranging from Additional Commissioner to Excise Inspector, Sub Inspector and Excise Constable. The Commissionerate is further organised in two mandals that is Kumaun and Garhwal headed by Joint Commissioner and two regions that is Dehradun/Haridwar region and Nainital/Udhamsinghnagar headed by Deputy Commissioner. There are 13 districts in which Assistant Excise Commissioner posted as District Excise Officer with the prime role of enforcement and collection of excise revenue.

Appeal and Revision

U.P. Excise Act 1910 (as adapted in Uttarakhand) section-11 provided the opportunity to aggrieved person appeal before the appellate authority that is Excise Commissioner, under proceeding by collector and every other excise officer and State Government may examine and review the proceedings under this act.
